

# Critical Information

All participants



1. **Masks** are mandatory for everyone except while playing on field OR on the bench
2. All players must **check-in**, including submitting Government Issued ID and COVID-19 documentation via the Umoja App. Check-in will be available from July 27th @ 8 AM. To complete:
  - Submit a selfie pic
  - Government issued ID (Passport, Driver's License). Birth Certificate can be used for Boy's U15, U12 and Soccer/Toddler Camps
  - COVID-19 Documentation for all participants ages 7+. The following are accepted:
    - **Vaccination Card** for fully vaccinated participants. Fully vaccinated is based on CDC guidelines (at least 14 days since receiving 2 shots of Pfizer/Moderna OR 1 shot of JJ)
    - **COVID-19 PCR test** taken after July 27th @ 8 AM
    - **COVID-19 Rapid Antigen test** taken after July 30th @ 8 AM. Umoja has arranged on-site testing for a subsidized rate of \$10 per test. Please see COVID-19 section on <https://umojaoutreach.org/games> to book an appointment

Ages under 7 can re-upload a picture of their Government Issued ID as proof of COVID-19 documentation to continue with the check-in process

Check-in will be marked successful and a player pass will be generated once documentation is verified
